OBITUARY

Mrs. Norma Yongue Holden, daughter of Mr. William Yongue Sr. and the late Mrs. Mildred Grigg Yongue was born in Charlotte, North Carolina. She departed this life Thursday, January 29, 1970 at the Presbyterian Hospital.

At an early age she united with the Seventh Street Presbyterian Church, now First United Presbyterian Church. She was a very active church member. She served her church in several capacities. Among these were Secretary of the Sunday Church School and Circle Leader.

She received her early education in the public Schools of Charlotte. She received her B.A. degree from Johnson C. Smith University in the class of 1948, one of the most outstanding classes ever to finish J. C. Smith. This class is now organized and Mrs. Holden was a very active member of this alumni organization. She received her M.A. degree from A & T. College, in Greensboro.

She was a member of the first faculty assigned to York Road Junior High School in 1955 under the principalship of Mr. Gerson L. Stroud. She watched and worked as the school changed from Junior High to Senior High then back to Junior High and finally to Robert F. Kennedy Junior High. She made an outstanding contribution to the lives of all the students who attended that school through this present time. She was truly a dedicated teacher giving up only when there was nothing else possible to do.

She was circle Leader for Circle No. 9 of the Women's Association of the First United Presbyterian Church. In addition to previously mentioned affiliations she was a member of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, The Thirteen-ettes Social Club, and the Q--ettes Fraternal Group.

To mourn their loss she leaves her husband, Mr. David E. Holden, her father, Mr. William Yongue Sr., one sister, Mrs. Mildred Y. Moseley, three brothers, Mr. William Yongue Jr., Mr. Robert Yongue and Mr. Charles Yongue and other relatives and friends.
