MR. CLARENCE EARL MORELAND, the youngest child of the late Reverend Doctor John F. Moreland and the late Grace Scott Moreland, was born in Charlotte, North Carolina on December 21, 1907.

His early education was obtained in the public schools of Charlotte. He recieved his Bachelor's degree from Livingstone College, Salisbury, North Carolina and his Master's degree from Columbia University, New York City

A dedicated educator all his adult life, C. E. Moreland was especially interested in the growth, developement and accomplishments of all children. His greatest desire was to create richer experiences for the students entrusted to his care.

His early administrative career began as a principal of Billingsville Elementary school and in 1954 was named principal of Northwest Junior High School. His community, church and civic responsibilities as well as his leadership ability were recognized by many who knew him. His professional and civic affiliations included Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity, local, state and national educational organizations; former member, Board of Directors, Mechanics and Farmers Bank and the School Workers' Federal Credit Union. For many years, he served both as a member and as chairman of the Board of Trustees at Grace A.M.E. Zion Church.

He departed this life on Monday August 3, 1992.
